



Latham Street, Brigstock

Built in the early 1600's and believed to be the former Stonemasons home, this beautiful stone semi-detached cottage has been lovingly cared for by the current owners. Character features prevail throughout with a stunning Inglenook fireplace with wood burner as the central focal point in the living dining room, beamed ceilings with no head height restriction, window seats and exposed stonework.

A five-bar gate to the side of the property opens onto a good size garden with driveway offering parking for numerous vehicles, leading to block paved hardstanding in front of the stone tandem length garage which at present allows space for a workshop at the rear. Additionally, a stone outbuilding with slate roof makes the perfect study or hobby room. The lawn has established planting and seating areas, one of which is a sunny patio area off the French doors from the living room.

The accommodation comprises a kitchen with wood wall and base cupboards, Rangemaster sink and moveable island, a characterful living dining room full of light with fireplace and French doors to the rear garden. Upstairs are two doubles and a single bedroom as well as a stylish shower room.
